

## Instructions for use of the 120L / 60L / 45L heating water bowl and a 20 L heating bucket

(items 601415, 600592, 601414, 600593)

## **WARNING**

This product is intended for use outdoors or in cold areas and requires basic precautions to avoid electric shock, personal injury or product damage.

- 1. The product should be installed with an earth fault breaker.
- 2. To avoid electric shock, do not immerse the product or transformer in water.
- 3. Do not connect the product before it is filled with water. Keep refilling the water so you never run out of it.
- 4. Hide or protect the cord and transformer so that pets cannot chew them.
- 5. Do not cover the transformer, it gives off some heat and needs ventilation.
- 6. Be sure to make the 24V connections carefully to avoid water or condensation on the connections.
- 7. Always keep the 24V connector clean and put on the protective cap every time you disconnect the tub, to avoid poor contact and heat generation which can destroy it.
- 8. This product has a thermostat that turns off the heater when the water is within the appropriate temperature range.

The product keeps water ice-free at ambient temperatures down to -20°C in light winds. In cold weather, high wind speeds cool your device more, so you need to shield your device from the wind.

## **Practical tips**

- Run the bowl/bucket before the cold sets in. Do not thaw already frozen water.
- In extremely cold weather, do not fill completely and preferably fill with moderate water temperature.
- If the cable length is not enough, use a connection cable approved for outdoor use.
- Mount the transformer so that it is attached to a wall or pole so that pets can't get access to it.

## **Troubleshooting**

- Check that there is 230 V in the wall socket.
- Check if 24V is coming out of the transformer when connected, if not, replace the transformer.
- Check the cables to make sure there are no breaks.
